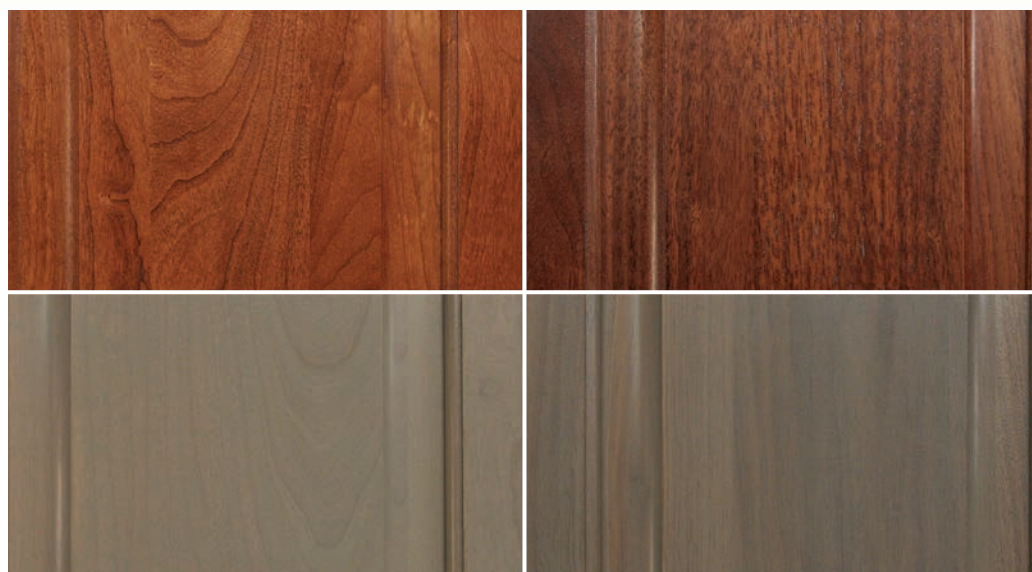

As its name suggests, Black Walnut is a rich, dark hardwood. Grown in the Eastern and Central U.S., Black Walnut has long been used for furniture, flooring, paneling and gun stocks.

The rich, smooth grain and deep color put Black Walnut in a class all its own. Grain patterns range from straight to irregular and wavy, with very few knots.

Colors vary from a light, pale brown to dark chocolate, with occasional darker brown streaks. A grey, purple or reddish cast may also occur.

Black Walnut is offered in both of our premium lines—Framed and Euro frameless—in many door styles and stain colors.



Color comparison: We put Cherry (left) and Black Walnut in Cayenne and Sea Drift side-by-side, to show how the deep, dark color of Black Walnut influence the stain color. The difference is even more dramatic with lighter woods like Beech or Maple.
